The halls are on a self-catering basis with shared cooking facilities. Private bathrooms may be available. *Full fees are required at the time of booking and are non-refundable in any case.*

GENERAL INFORMATION

- The minimum age for Pre-Sessional courses is 18.
- The school is closed on public holidays.
- LSI Portsmouth has a **24-hour emergency phone number:** 0780 339 2476 (or +44 780 339 2476 if phoning from outside Britain).
- You should arrive at school at 08.30am on your first day.
- **INSURANCE: We strongly advise you to take out travel and medical insurance before leaving home. This should cover loss or damage to personal possessions and loss of tuition fees if you have to finish your course early for any reason. As well as private insurance, if you are a European National, please remember to bring your European Health Insurance Card (EHIC)**
- LSI Portsmouth keeps personal information in both electronic and paper format. When requested, this information is passed onto third parties such as the British Council, ISI and UKVI.
- LSI Portsmouth may use photographs or short video clips from school social activities for marketing and promotional materials. You will be asked whether you are happy for us to use images that you may feature in at the start of your course.

- A minimum of 90% attendance is required in order to pass the Pre-Sessional course.
- Please note you will be expected to have your own wireless-enabled laptop computer - this is essential equipment for the course.

VISAS

If you are from the **EU, Switzerland, Iceland, Norway or Liechtenstein**, you **may** need a visa. If you come from any other country, you **do** need a visa and cannot work in the UK.

It is your responsibility to ensure you have the correct type of visa and sufficient duration to study in the UK. There are 2 main types of student visa: Student Visa and Short-Term Student Visa (6 months or 11 months). If you apply for a Student Visa, we will only issue you with a CAS number if we are satisfied that you both intend and are able to complete the course of study booked, your Student Visa application meets UKVI requirements and all your tuition fees and cost of the CAS have been paid in full.

We are obliged to inform the Home Office if you do not follow your visa conditions.

HOW TO BOOK

If you already hold a conditional offer for a degree course with one of our partners, please complete our registration form and email it to admissions@lsi-portsmouth.co.uk

We must also receive a copy of your passport, current Secure English Language Test (SELT) certificate and a copy of your University conditional offer, if applicable.

If you wish to apply for the composite programme (your chosen degree course together with the appropriate 4-week, 7-week or 11-week Pre-Sessional English course), please contact LSI Portsmouth at admissions@lsi-portsmouth.co.uk

In order to process your booking we must receive full course fees. If your offer is a composite unconditional offer, you will need to pay the full course fees to LSI Portsmouth and a deposit of to the University you are applying to. Please contact your University to find out how much you are required to pay.

The payment can be made via a bank transfer (please send us proof of this payment) or via Flywire at www.lsi-portsmouth.flywire.com

After receiving your registration form, required documents and payment, we will send you a booking confirmation and any necessary immigration documents. Documents for visa applications will be sent once the terms and conditions above have been met. Accommodation details and taxi transfer details (if booked) will be sent around 2 weeks before the start of the course – please send us your arrival information as soon as possible.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

- In booking with us, **you agree to accept LSI Portsmouth's Terms and Conditions**
- If you book via a representative or Educational Tour Operator (ETO), their terms & conditions may apply.
- **Full payment of course fees is required for all bookings.**
- The course fees include materials and course books.
- LSI Portsmouth reserves the right to refuse an enrolment.
- LSI Portsmouth is not liable for loss of tuition or other services caused by factors outside of our control (natural events e.g. flooding, earthquake, storms). Refunds in these instances will not be made.
- Refunds for cancelled places will only be made in the event that you are refused a visa. If this should happen, a copy of the visa refusal letter should be sent to LSI and once received all tuition fees less an administrative charge of £300.00 or less 10% of tuition fees, whichever is the higher, will be refunded.
- Homestay fees are refundable subject to 1 full week's notice.
- University Halls of Residence fees are non-refundable in any case.
- LSI Portsmouth reserves the right to ask students to leave the school without refunding or crediting tuition fees in the event of misconduct, criminal behaviour or serious attendance problems. Please see the school's website for our disciplinary procedures.
- Students who are asked to leave the course due to poor performance will not be entitled to any refund or credit for the future but may transfer the balance of any outstanding fees to an IELTS preparation course if they wish; an administration charge of £300 will be made for this.
- Unacceptable behaviour in accommodation arranged by the school may result in students being asked to leave – we cannot guarantee that we will be able to find suitable, alternative accommodation.

Changes

- A course change fee of £25 is required on any changes made to the original booking – where we have to produce new documents / invoices; dates; course changes (but not upgrades); adding / cancelling accommodation and transfers; shortening courses. Note there will be no charge if the changes are due to a visa delay.
