

General English and Volunteering at LSI/IH Portsmouth

COURSE OBJECTIVE:

Our Full-time General English course will help you study and practice across all areas of the language.

The course offers 22.5 hours per week, in groups of maximum 12 students per class (average 8). The lessons focus on improving your grammar with plenty of opportunities for speaking and using the language in context. You will also practise English for everyday situations and use your listening, reading, writing, and speaking skills to explore a range of interesting topics.

- 22.5 hours (60 minutes) per week
- Start any Monday (except bank holidays)
- · Minimum length 2 weeks

- Maximum students per class 12 (average 8)
- Minimum age 18 (average 23)
- Minimum level A1



General English Timetable

This intensive programme includes 22.5 hours of tuition plus self-access study hours. Students may also join the evening and weekend social activities.

No lessons on Friday afternoons, leaving students free to do supervised self-access study or join the social programme. Alternatively, students can choose to do 1:1 classes at this time (at an extra cost).
