



Bullying and Abusive Behaviour in Class, Host Family, Accommodation and LSI Portsmouth-Organised Social Events

LSI Portsmouth is committed to providing a safe, welcoming environment for all students and staff and will not tolerate any form of harassment or abusive behaviour.

The following are **not** tolerated at LSI Portsmouth:

- Bullying or abuse of any kind (physical or verbal)
- Racism or racist language
- Excessive and/or loud swearing
- Sexual harassment of any kind
- Offensive comments about religion, beliefs, culture, age, gender, gender identity, sexual orientation or size.
- Aggressive behaviour towards staff, students or visitors (e.g. shouting at other individuals inappropriately, kicking furniture, etc.)
- Theft (stealing other people's property or LSI Portsmouth's property)
- Vandalism (e.g. deliberately breaking school furniture, computers, graffiti etc.)
- Any behavior which undermines [core British values](#)
- Any illegal activity

If a **student** experiences or witnesses bullying or abusive behavior, they should contact a member of staff immediately. These are primarily:

- Our Teachers, Student Services Staff & Welfare Officers
- The Directors of Academic and Quality
- The Principal or Operations

If a **teacher** experiences or witnesses bullying or abusive behavior, they should contact the Director of Academic and Quality, who will, if necessary, involve the Principal. When the Director of Academic and Quality and, if necessary, the Principal have been notified, an appropriate course of action will be decided.

Cases of abusive behaviour may result in disciplinary action in the case of staff or, in the case of students, termination of their course with no refund.

Important: It is the school's decision if a student's behaviour is unacceptable or not. If a student's behaviour is unacceptable and they have not heeded verbal warnings given by LSI Portsmouth staff, the school will give them a written warning. If unacceptable

behaviour occurs again, the school will order the student to leave the school and their accommodation (if arranged by LSI Portsmouth) immediately with no refund of any fees.

Please note that the school may order the student to leave the school and their accommodation immediately with no refund of fees and **no written warning** if the behaviour is very serious in the school's opinion.
